Without this document, the University will not be able to validate your final registration and without a final registration, the Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs - Directorate of Immigration will not be able to issue you a residence permit. That means that you will then be asked to return to your country of origin since you will not meet all the requirements.

Please also complete and sign the attached declaration and present it to us on your arrival in the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg. This and paying your fees will be necessary to make your application definitive.

Studying at the University with a residence permit

Who is concerned?

- Third-country nationals are required to have an authorisation to stay and then a residence permit if they
 wish to study in Luxembourg. These countries are either not EU member states or have no relevant residency
 agreement with the EU. Non-EU countries with residency agreements are: the UK (until at least 31/12/2020),
 Iceland, Norway, Liechtenstein and Switzerland.
- One is **considered to be a student** after being accepted by a higher education institution in Luxembourg to follow a **full-time study course as the main activity**, if this will lead to a higher education qualificiation issued by the same institution.

University diploma or Higher Education (Registration in the register of titles)

With a view to his definitive enrollment in a master's programme at the University of Luxembourg, any student who do not hold a bachelor's degree corresponding to at least 180 ECTS according to the framework of the Bologna process, issued by a higher education institution located in another Member State of the European Union, in a Member State of the European Economic Area or in a Swiss Confederation recognised by the competent authorities of the State in question and certifying higher education recognised by the same competent authorities, must compulsorily submit an application to register his diploma in the register of qualifications, higher education section at the Ministry of Higher Education and Research in Luxembourg.

Estimate of a monthly budget for a student in Luxembourg

Below is a guide to some costs you are likely to incur: both variable costs (depending on your decisions related to housing, meal choices etc.) and fixed costs.

According to the Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs, a student's financial needs correspond to at least 80% of Luxembourg's social incursion income. This equates to a monthly budget of **1,700** €to cover costs such as:

University enrolment fees	200 € (minimum)
Medical insurance	280 €/semester
Student residence	450 €/month
Rental insurance	130 €/year
Rental guarantee	450 €/year - reimbursed at end of tenancy
Meals (5 € each)	300 €/month
Mobile subscription	30 €/month
Leisure (cinema, sport, evenings out,)	150 €/month
Educational material	+/- 400 €/year

On arrival you will need around $2,500 \in$ to cover the following costs: course fees, medical cover, rental guarantee, a month's rent, rental insurance and food.
