NOTES

1. Mauritius passports are issued and renewed by the competent authorities in Mauritius and by the Diplomatic Missions and Consulates of Mauritius abroad to which applications should be made. In countries where Mauritius Diplomatic Missions or Consulates have not been set up, such application may be made to the nearest Mauritius High Commission, Embassy or Consulate.
2. A Mauritius passport shall, unless otherwise stated, be valid for a period of ten years. Where it is issued for a lesser period it may be renewed for a further period provided the total period does not exceed ten years from the original date of issue. If at any time the passport contains no further space for visas, a new passport must be obtained.
3. The possession of a passport does not exempt the holder from compliance with any immigration regulations in force in any territory or from the necessity of obtaining a visa or permit where required. Passports endorsed as valid for the British Commonwealth are available for travel to any territory under British protection or trusteeship.
4. Mauritius Citizens who are residents abroad should at the earliest opportunity register their names and addresses with the nearest High Commission, Embassy or Consulate. Changes of addresses or departure from the country should also be similarly notified.
5. This passport remains the property of the Government of Mauritius and may be withdrawn at any time.
6. It is a valuable document and shall not be altered in any way or allowed to pass into the possession of an unauthorized person. If lost or destroyed, the fact and circumstances should be immediately reported to the Passport Office, Port Louis, or to the nearest Mauritius High Commission, Embassy or Consulate, and to the local Police. New passports can only be issued in such cases after exhaustive enquiries.
